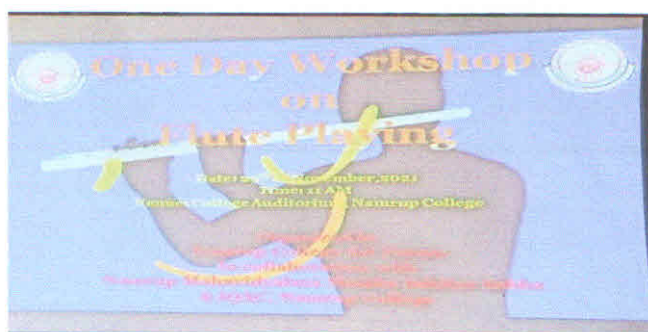


**Report on**

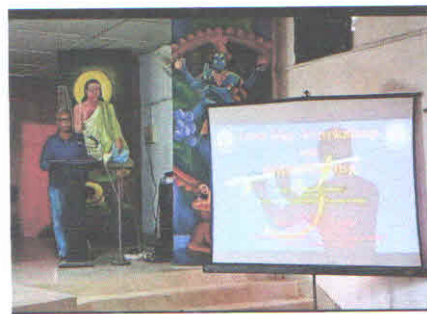
