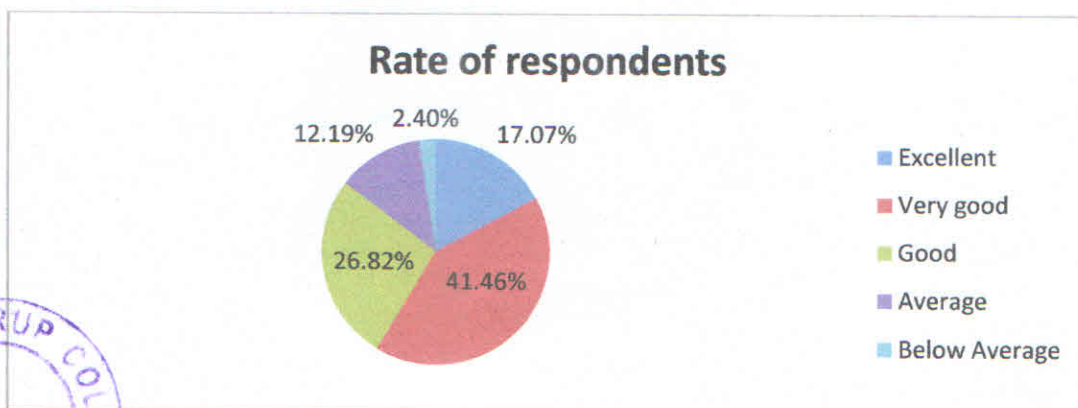

Report on Parents Feedback, 2020-2021

Every year, a feedback is being collected by IQAC, Namrup College from the parents of the students on the academic atmosphere, teaching process, evaluation process and other related aspects which is found to be helpful in improving the teaching-learning environment and overall development of the college. In the academic year 2020-2021 too the feedback from the parents has been collected on certain important areas through the methodology of questionnaire. The questionnaire consist of total 8 parameters/ questions have been given to the parents of all the final semester students of the year, on which the respondents provided their responses in each question by marking on any one of the options viz, excellent, very good, good, average, below average attached with Parameter 1 to 5 and for the remaining parameters from 6 to 8 which are basically related to suggestions from the respondents on some important aspects related to institution and the students like mentoring ways adopted by them for their children to achieve overall development for their future, suggestion to the institution on adoption of new courses related to carrier orientation of the students and suggestion to college for adoption of certain strategies for the students to compete at global standard on which the respondents responded accordingly. The total number of respondents (parents of students from Arts and Science streams) from whom feedback have been collected are 82 (eighty two). In the following diagrams, a detailed analysis is attempted to present on various data collected from the parents respondents on the Parameter 1 to 5 as feedback on the overall institutional framework and teaching environment of the college.

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Diagram 2: Parameter 2: The academic environment of the institution.

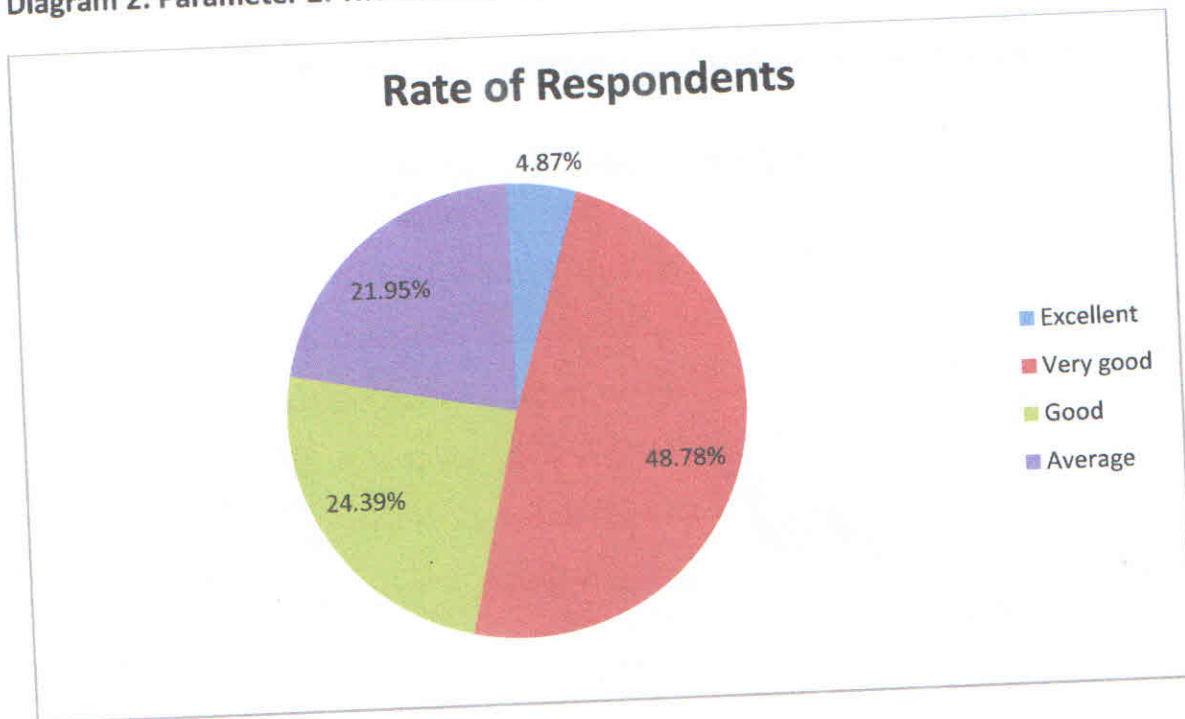
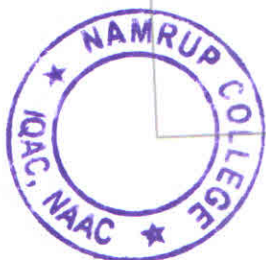
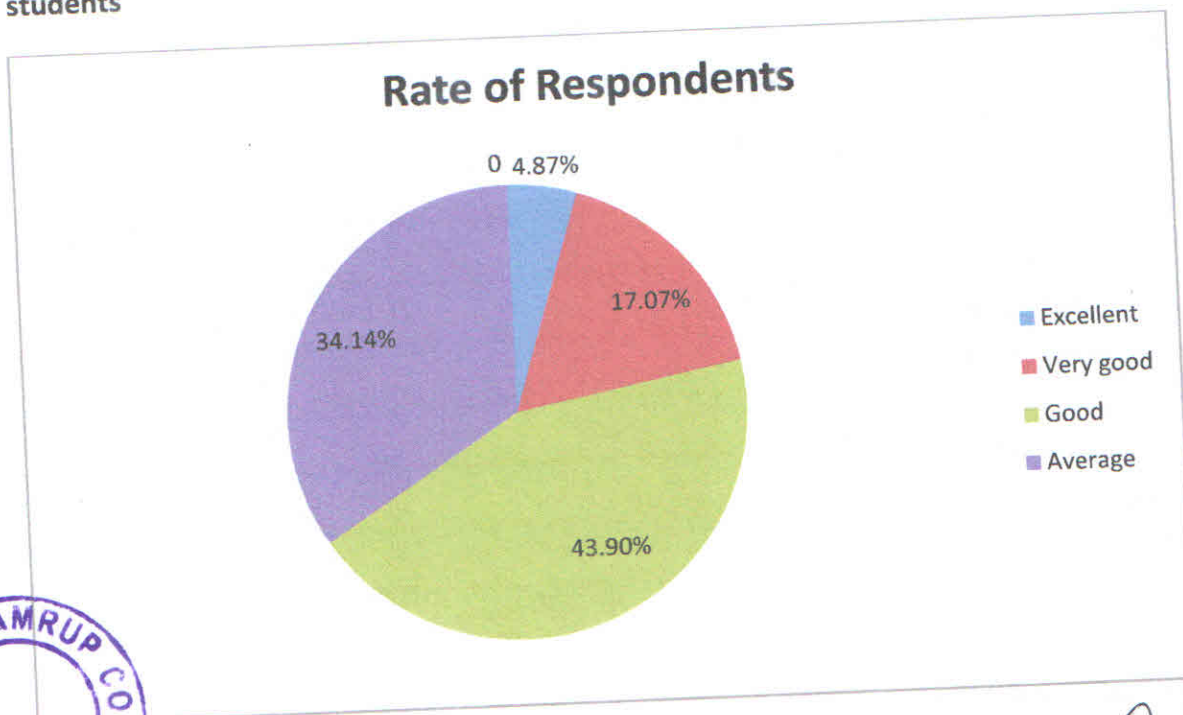


Diagram 3: Parameter 3: Conduct of co-curricular activities the all round development of students



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Diagram 4: Parameter 4: How do you rate the relation between you and the college?

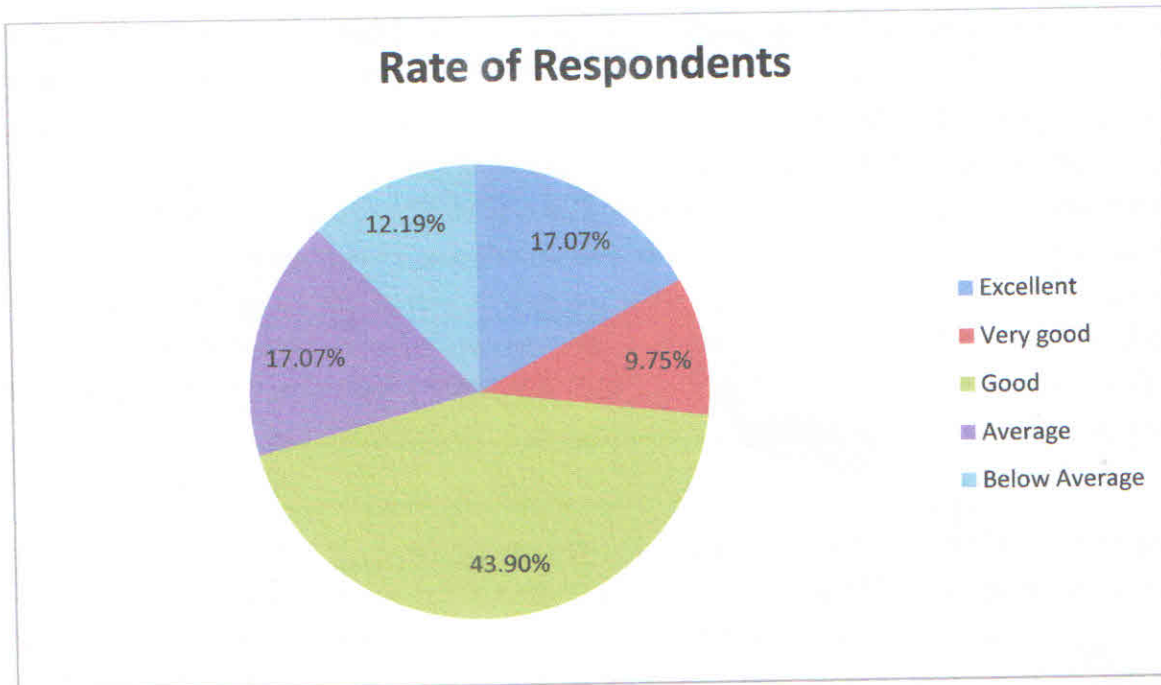
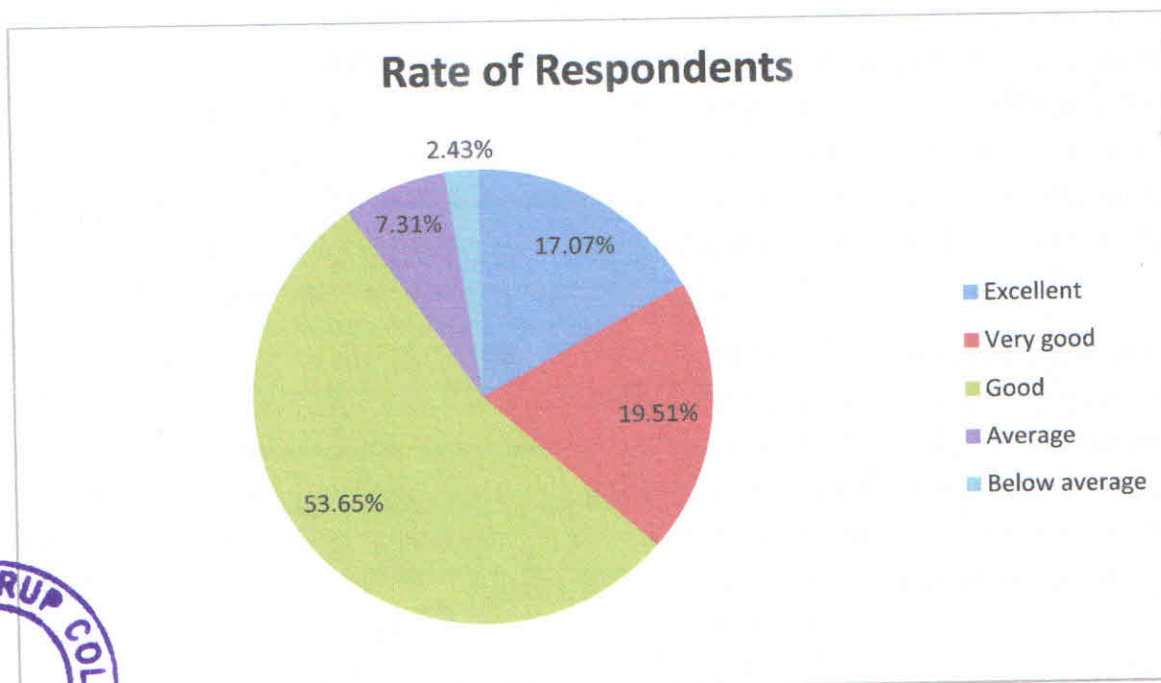


Diagram 5: Parameter 5: Satisfaction about the infrastructure facilities provided by the college to your child



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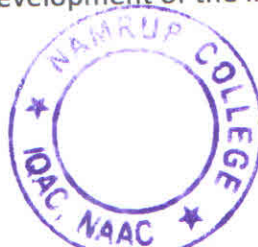
Brief Summary:

Based on the data collected from the respondents (parents) on the parameters 1 to 5 and diagrams for each parameter, it can be concluded that a mixed kind of responses are received. In Parameter 1, it has been found that, out of 100 % (total 82 respondents) 17.07% respondents marked for excellent, 41.46% marked for very good, 26.82% marked for good, 12.19% marked for average and only 2.40% marked for below average. The result on this parameter which is related to rate on teaching learning practices of the institution towards the students is quite satisfactory as maximum responded for very good and responses to option excellent is also not very low and moreover to option good is quite high. In short, it can be said that respondents views on the teaching learning methods are found to be effective by the parents which is definitely a strong point for the institution and its development.

For Parameter 2 again, the rating is very much satisfactory which stands for rating on the academic atmosphere of the institution. Out of 100 percent (82 respondents in number), 48.78% responded for option very good that is something very positive response, then 24.39% marked for option good, 21.95% marked for average and 4.87% marked for excellent. Overall rating gives a very satisfactory picture as maximum responded for very good option and not a single responded for below average and this is also another strong point for the institution.

For Parameter 3, which stands for rating for conduct of co-curricular activities for the all round development of students, the result is not very satisfactory or it can be said that the parents are not very much satisfied with this aspect as very low percentage that is, 4.87% responded for option excellent and only 17.07% responded for very good. This produced a very disappointing picture. For option good 43.90% responded for option good and 34.14% responded for average option which is found to be very high. Depending on this rate on the options, it can be stated that it is very necessary for the institution to undertake some effective measures on co-curricular activities conducted by the college for the all round development of the real asset of the college that is, the students.

Parameter 4 which stands for rating on relations between parents/guardians and the college. On this parameter very much mixed responses are found. 17.07% responded for excellent, 9.75% responded for very good, 43.90% responded for good, 17.07% responded for average and even for below average 12.19% responded. The result based on the data on this parameter definitely requires for the college to adopt some effective measures on an urgent basis to improve the relation between the parents and the college as this is also an integral component for the overall development of the institution.





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Parameter 5 which stands for satisfaction level on the infrastructure facilities provided by the college to the students is not completely unsatisfactory but still some initiatives needed to be taken by the institution to improve the infrastructural facilities as for excellent option only 17.07% responded and 19.51% responded for very good. Then 53.65% responded for good, 7.31% responded for average and 2.43% responded for below average.

Then for parameters 6,7 and 8 suggestions are required mainly from the parents and the suggestions are found to be very positive in these three parameters as maximum respondents answered that they mentor their own children through various ways at home for their overall development, then most of the parents are satisfied with the existing courses in the institution and no such major suggestions are given to adopt any new course related to carrier orientation of the students and majority of the parents have not suggested for adoption of any new thing by the college for the students to make them capable to compete at global standard.

Hence, overall feedback from the parents in this academic year of 2020-2021 is quite satisfactory on the institutional framework and this is an impetus for the development and progress of the institution.
