This study was taken by 05 students and 3 teachers of the department of education in the academic year of 2014-15. Joypore Maj Kapahua Gaon and Joypore Borherum Gaon were randomly selected as the area of the study. The people of these villages were taken as the sample of the study. The samples were selected by using simple random sampling method. In this study, Questionnaire and interview methods were taken for collecting the data. After analyzing the collected data the findings of the study were such the literacy rate of male is comparatively higher than female. The causes of low rate of literacy among female were negative attitude of parents towards education, due to poverty, negative attitude towards girl education due to marriage in early age. In 2016-17, the topic was selected for study "A study of literacy rate and socio-economic condition of Maj Kapahua Gaon under Kenduguri Gaon Panchayat of Joypure Block, Dibrugarh District." The objective of the study was to know the socio-economic condition of people living in Maj Kapahua Gaon. This study was taken by 09 students and 04 teachers of the Department of Education in the academic year of 2016-17. Maj Kapahua Gaon was randomly selected as the area of the study. The people of this village were taken as the sample of the study and are selected by using simple random sampling method. Questionnaire and personal interview were taken as the methods for collecting the data. After analyzing the collected data the result of the study as the maximum people of this village were depend on agriculture. Only a few people were working as employee on BVFCL factory. Most of the people were illiterate and for that reason they didn't get any job. The causes of low literacy of that village were-illiterate of parents, lack encouragement towards education, poverty etc. In economic aspect, this village was poor in condition. The village was lacking in pure drinking water facilities, health center, playground, auditorium, library etc.
